Team Formation — Teams are formed through a league draft. Players may sign up with a buddy to guarantee placement on the same team. Team formation will take place Saturday, April 16th. Registrations must be post-marked by April 9th to ensure a spot on the team. Coaches will inform parents once teams are formed, of name and practice date/time.

Elementary and Youth Divisions — Teams are assigned one manager, one assistant manager, and one sponsor. Children of the manager, assistant manager, and a sponsor-designated player are automatically assigned to the team along with their siblings in the same division. Players not on preset roster may sign up with a buddy through the "Buddy System".

Middle School Divisions — Teams may be formed through a preset roster presented to the league containing up to 16 players with a minimum of one-half being female players. All preset rosters must be presented to the League Registrar by no later than April 9th.

Player Registrations — DUE APRIL 9th
A registration form must be completed for each player and submitted with the \$65.00 player registration fee. The player's parent or legal guardian must sign the registration form.

- If ordering parent shirt(s), the amount must be included with the registration fee. Be sure to include your size and check the box for your child's size. No parent shirt orders accepted after April 4th.
- No telephone registrations will be accepted.

Parent Participation — In our efforts to assure the safety of all children participating in the NRSA program, we perform background checks annually on all coaches and umpires.

About Our Program —

Founded in 1978, Northland Rotational Softball is a coed youth recreational softball league for players from three years old through seniors in high school. Rules in the elementary and youth divisions are structured so that each player "rotates" through each of the defensive positions during the game. On offense, all players present take their turn at the plate. With this approach, no player is a substitute. The program's motto is "Winning is the result, not the aim."

League Divisions —

Preschool Division — Depending on interest, this division is for three, four, and five year olds who have not yet attended kindergarten. Heavy parent participation and a league facilitator provide fundamentals and group/team activities in a series of one-hour Saturday morning clinics which will begin mid-May. Fee will be \$25.00.

Elementary Division — For players who are currently in kindergarten, first, and second grades.

Youth Division — For players who are currently in third, fourth, and fifth grades.

Middle School Division — For players who are currently in sixth, seventh, and eighth grades.
