UPCOMING VACCINATION CLINIC



Clay County Public Health Center will be providing the **Meningococcal Vaccine (MCV)** and the **Human Papillomavirus Vaccine (HPV)** for juniors attending Winnetonka High School on February 15th at 8:30am.

The MCV is a required for all students 16 years of age and older before entering 12th grade. All 11th grade students are encouraged to attend the clinic.

There is no fee for the vaccine regardless of insurance status. If you need this vaccine, please have your parent **complete the front and back of the consent form and return it to the school nurse** by February 8, 2018. The information can be found online on the school website or stop by to see the nurse for a packet.
