North Kansas City Schools

Our district has a total enrollment of approximately 20,753 students in 22 elementary, 4 middle, 2 6th Grade Centers and 4 high schools. Each high school has received A+ Schools Designation from the state of Missouri. District students score well above national averages on standardized achievement tests. Honors classes, college credit, and Advanced Placement classes are available on all four high school campuses. The International Baccalaureate program offered by the district is available at North Kansas City High School only.

Community

We are a suburban area with a population of more than 100,000, located ten minutes north of downtown Kansas City, Missouri. The district encompasses 82 square miles.

GPA and Class Rank

GPA is based on a 4.0 scale (A=4; B=3; C=2; D=1; F=0). Class rank is based on a student's accumulated grade points plus distinction points for satisfactory completion of Distinguished Achievement Program (DAP) courses. Distinction points are added to the grade point sum prior to computing an average to determine class rank. GPA and class rank are calculated at the end of the 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, and 8th semesters. Classes may be repeated to obtain a higher GPA.
