A three-sport high school athlete, Randy received a football scholarship to Southwest Missouri State University. After graduating in 1976, he was hired as a coach and instructor by Springfield Public Schools, where he spent more than 40 years. During his career, Randy coached football, basketball, wrestling and track, and served as a teacher, curriculum supervisor, assistant principal, principal and director of Alternative Programs. He earned two advanced degrees in school administration from Drury University.

As director of Alternative Programs and the district's review officer, Randy found his passion – helping at-risk students graduate from high school. His community work also revolves around young people and helping those less fortunate. He volunteers for an urban youth sports camp, supports kids who are disadvantaged through Smitty's Mid-West Boxing Club and takes his therapy dog Rocky to visit schools, hospitals and care facilities.
