Dear Parent/Guardian,

Keeping your child immunized is important to their health. Clay County Public Health Center provides thousands of immunizations to children from all over Clay County each year. Our Registered Nurses will offer required school immunizations for the North Kansas City School District at a special offsite clinic. To be eligible for the school clinic the student must be going into 8th grade or 12th grade. We accept and will bill most major insurance plans including Medicaid. Students without insurance or insurance coverage that does not include vaccines, can also receive the vaccine at no cost during the school clinic. No child will be turned away for inability to pay.

The North Kansas City School District 8th and 12th grade clinic will take place **July 23, 2020 at Oak Park High School**. **Services will be offered by appointment only.** Walk-ins will not be accommodated.

Clay County Public Health Center will offer the following required vaccines:

Middle School (8th grade)

Tdap

Meningococcal

High School (12th grade)

Meningococcal

To Register your student(s), please use the [Online Registration Consent Form](#) or navigate to our website: www.clayhealth.com/immunizations. The registration must be completed at least one week prior to your scheduled school clinic. During the online registration process, you will be required to attach a picture of both the **front and back** of your insurance card. You will receive a confirmation message after the registration is complete. Once your application is complete, a Clay County Public Health Center staff member will call you to schedule an appointment. Appointments are limited, so register soon.

- We strongly encourage students and parents/guardians to wear a mask or other face covering
- Bring a copy of your most up-to-date vaccine record
- **Please only bring one parent or guardian. Do not bring siblings.**
- All students, parents/guardians, and staff will be required to be symptom free. Temperatures and symptoms will be checked on all students and parents/guardians.
- Social distancing should be practiced throughout the clinic (a minimum of 6 feet from all times)
- Students should eat breakfast or lunch and be well hydrated before their appointment.
