



Throughout the spring and summer, NKC Schools has implemented a comprehensive plan for families to access food. **Our meal distribution services will resume beginning Monday, August 24 and continue through Thursday, September 3.** During this period, NKC Schools students will have access to free meals. The following sites are designated as “grab-n-go” food pick up locations Monday through Friday between 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. and 4 p.m. to 6 p.m. Each grab and go package will contain a breakfast and lunch.
