- Students will participate in e-learning for the ten school days between March 23 and April 3.
  Teachers and administrators will be in contact by noon on Monday with more information. Families will have the choice between food delivery at bus stops (occurring between 9:00 a.m.—noon) or drive-through pick-up at each of our high schools (any time between 1 and 3 p.m.). Communication later this week will narrow the timeframe for food delivery at bus stops and ensure you know the location closest to your home. Procedures will also be outlined for pick-up.
