HIGH SCHOOL VIRTUAL ACADEMY

North Kansas City Schools' **High School Virtual Academy** is a unique learning opportunity available to district students. Beginning in the fall of 2021, a fully virtual ninth through twelfth grade curriculum will be offered as an alternative to brick and mortar schooling to our families. Participation in the High School Virtual Academy requires demonstrated success in a virtual environment and a semester-long commitment.



Students will learn via Canvas five days per week. The academy may include asynchronous (independent) and some synchronous (live) activities.



Virtual students will learn at the same pace as their in-person peers, engaging in high-quality, authentic learning experiences from home.



Beyond typical class activities, students will interact with classmates via chat and discussion boards and collaborate on course projects.



Teachers will consistently communicate and connect with families in much the same way as in a classroom setting. Students qualifying for IEP or ELL services will be supported based on individual plans.
