



INCLEMENT WEATHER GUIDELINES FOR ATHLETICS

When school is in session and weather alert services are predicting inclement weather:

The Executive Director of Support Services/Athletics and Activities will review weather forecasts with the Assistant Superintendent of Support Services, the Director of Transportation and the Superintendent. The decision to travel to away events, host home events or hold practices will be made through the Support Services office. A conference call with all activities directors will be held at 9:00 AM to finalize decisions.

When school is dismissed early due to inclement weather:

1. The Executive Director of Support Services/Athletics and Activities will review weather forecasts with the Assistant Superintendent of Support Services, the Director of Transportation and the Superintendent.
2. All practices will be canceled.
3. All sub-varsity home and away athletic events will be postponed.
4. Varsity athletic events will be reviewed on an event-by-event basis and the decision to travel to away varsity events or host home varsity events will be made through the Support Services office.

When school is canceled due to inclement weather:

1. The Executive Director of Support Services/Athletics and Activities will review weather forecasts with the Assistant Superintendent of Support Services, the Director of Transportation and the Superintendent. A conference call with all activities directors will be held at 9:00 AM to finalize decisions.
2. All sub-varsity home and away athletic events will be postponed with the exception of tournaments. Sub-varsity tournaments will be reviewed on an event-by-event basis and the decision to host or travel to such tournaments will be made through the Support Services office.
3. Varsity athletic events will be reviewed on an event-by-event basis and the decision to travel to away varsity events or host home varsity events will be made through the Support Services office.
4. If practices are held, they will be optional for each participant.
