For a child to be eligible for free Title I preschool, they must be 4, on or before July 31, 2020 and living within the North Kansas City Schools Elementary school attendance areas.



Screenings will be conducted from January 2020 through May 2020.

The purpose of the Early Childhood Screening is to assess the development of each child in the areas that are vital to the learning process, such as language, gross and fine motor and social skills. Children will be asked to participate in a variety of screening activities. **The Parent or Legal Guardian MUST be present to authorize the screening, otherwise the screening cannot take place.**

Each screening session will last approximately one hour and 15 minutes. Acceptance into the North Kansas City Schools Early Childhood program is dependent upon the child's cumulative score from the screening. Those children with the most need as determined by multiple criteria are accepted into the program.
