SHE IS THE FIRST FEMALE TO WIN A REGIONAL EMMY FOR THE PRODUCTION OF AN NFL TELEVISION GAME AND SHE IS THE FIRST FEMALE TO SERVE ON THE NFL'S 101 AWARDS EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE.
